Program Description

Purpose:

The Snoqualmie Valley Schools Foundation Educator of the Year program is an annual program developed to recognize and honor exemplary educators in the Snoqualmie Valley School District.

Award Categories:

Four educators are honored each year, including one from each of the following categories:

- > Preschool through 5th grade certified staff (teacher, counselor, principal, librarian, etc.)
- ➤ 6th grade through 8th grade certified staff
- > 9th grade through 12th grade certified staff
- ➤ Classified staff (custodian, food services, transportation, maintenance, office, paraeducators, tech support etc.)

Nominators:

An educator can be nominated by students, parents, educators or other members of the community.

Eligibility:

The nominee must be a staff member employed by the Snoqualmie Valley School District in at least their third year with the district.

Selection Criteria:

- Inspires students of all backgrounds and abilities to learn
- Has the respect and admiration of students, parents, and colleagues
- Leads by example
- Plays an active and useful role in the scholastic environment.

Process:

Nomination packages must be submitted by February 7th, 2020. An independent selection committee comprised of community leaders will review applications. Winners will be notified by the first week of March and honored on March 19th, 2020 at the Snoqualmie Valley Schools Foundation's annual spring luncheon.

Support from a variety of sources provides the selection committee with a broad picture of the candidate. We will not accept letters of support written by direct supervisors.
